# Kenana Knitters

Jane Wacuka 58years old, came to Kenana Knitters in 2014. She has been a regular knitter for the last 4 years. She is a mother of 4 children.

Jane has lived in the Molo, Elburgon—Nakuru county for over 15 years. The year 2007/8 following the post election violence in Kenya was her worst year. Clashes broke out in the Rift Valley and the Molo area where she lived was one of the places that was worst hit. The violence left her and her family completely destitute. Her property was destroyed and her family was left homeless. Like many others she came with her children to seek shelter and safety at Kenana Farm during this time.

Jane moved away from Molo and found casual work in places like Nakuru, Nyahururu, Nairobi and returned in 2013. In 2014 she joined the Kenana Knitters.

Through her work with the knitters she has been able to provide a stable home and educate her children, 3 of who have now completed high school. Her youngest son joined high school in 2017. She has recently together with her husband and oldest son been able to invest in the purchase of another property at Ol Kalau, where the family intends to build a home and settle permanently.
